Call for Applications

Homelessness Partnering Strategy Rural and Remote Newfoundland and Labrador are pleased to invite application submissions for funding. The Homelessness Partnering Strategy (HPS) is a community-based program aimed at preventing and reducing homelessness by providing direct support and funding to communities across Canada. Eligible applicants for funding include, but are not limited to: non-profit organizations, individuals, municipalities, for-profit enterprises, Aboriginal organizations, and more. In order to be eligible for funding under the Rural and Remote funding stream, project activities must take place in rural and remote communities in *Newfoundland and Labrador*. Preference will be given to projects taking place in communities with a population of 25,000 or less. Available amount for this Call for Applications is **\$81,192**. This amount is subject to change. All amendments to this call will be advertised. All proposed projects must be completed no later than **March 31, 2016**.

Applications must be post marked no later than **November 6th, 2015**. Applications submitted after this deadline may not be considered.
