Introduction

The Town of Grand Falls-Windsor is seeking proposals for labour cost related to painting five traffic control boxes in Grand Falls-Windsor. The Exploits River is to be the main theme behind the concepts.

Scope of Work

Key requirements include:

- Council would like to be presented with 15-20 different sketches of ideas
 for consideration by the committee from the successful bidder after being
 awarded the project. The Exploits River is to be the main theme behind the
 concepts. When these are presented, Council will make the final selection
 on the sketches to be used.
- The Town of Grand Falls-Windsor will provide all materials necessary to complete the work. This list will be provided to the Town by the successful bidder.
- There are five traffic control boxes to be painted:
 - Duggan Street/Cromer Avenue Lights

Length = 76.2 cm Height = 140.3 cm Width = 47 cm

Cromer Avenue Lights

Length = 76.2 cm Height = 120 cm Width = 46.5 cm

Union Street Lights

Length = 77.5 cm Height = 193 cm Width = 43.2 cm

Brown Avenue Lights

Length = 75.3 cm Height = 123.5 cm Width = 44.5 cm

Hardy Avenue Lights

Length = 83.7 cm Height = 183 cm Width = 46 cm

- Traffic control boxes to be cleaned and primed by the Town of Grand Falls-Windsor prior to painting.
- Traffic control boxes to be painted on all sides.
- When art work is dry, artist to apply a protected coating (supplied by the Town).
- A safety vest will be provided and must be worn at all times.

General Conditions

- 1. All taxes, if applicable, must be included.
- 2. Incomplete, conditional, obscure, or qualified proposals may be rejected as invalid.
- 3. In case of tie low bids, the Town of Grand Falls-Windsor reserves the right to use the most expedient means available to arrive at an award.
- 4. Emailed proposals will only be accepted as a change to the proposal already received.

- 5. The Town of Grand Falls-Windsor reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and to accept any bid deemed to be in the Town's best interest. The lowest or any proposal will not necessarily be accepted.
- 6. The Town will not defray any expenses incurred by the bidders in the preparation and submissions of their proposal.
