The revised budget for 2021 showed an increase in the operating surplus in the amount of 1,286,962. The amount above only relates to direct savings in relation to the work stoppage. The difference are other savings that are indirectly related to the work stoppage. These areas include fuel purchases, parts for fleet that weren't in use, office supplies, safety clothing purchases, leave accumulation amounts, and other MERC costs.
